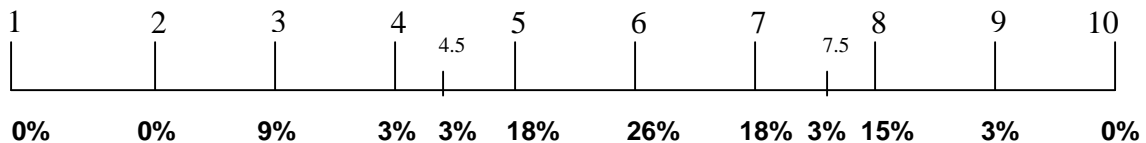

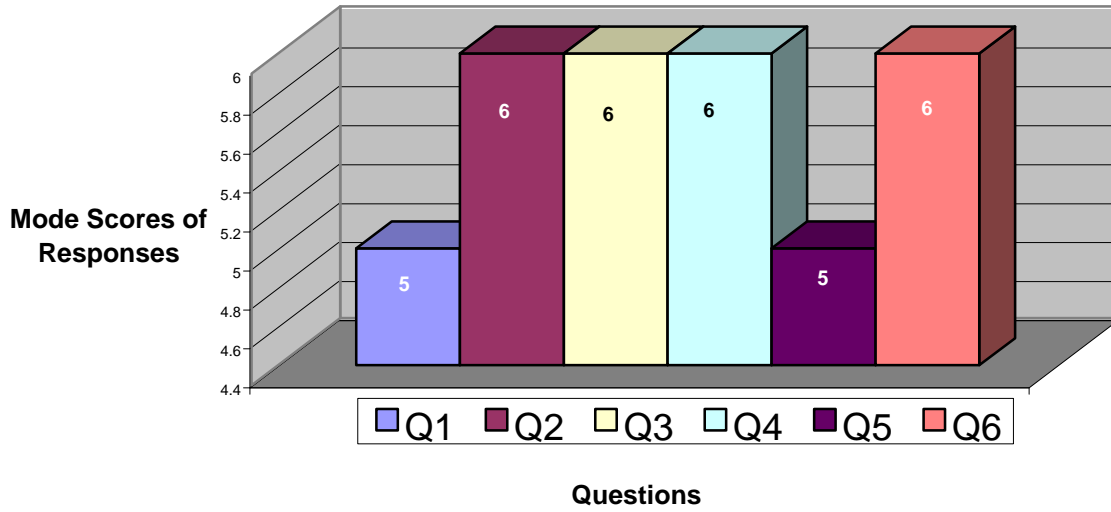

Most confident

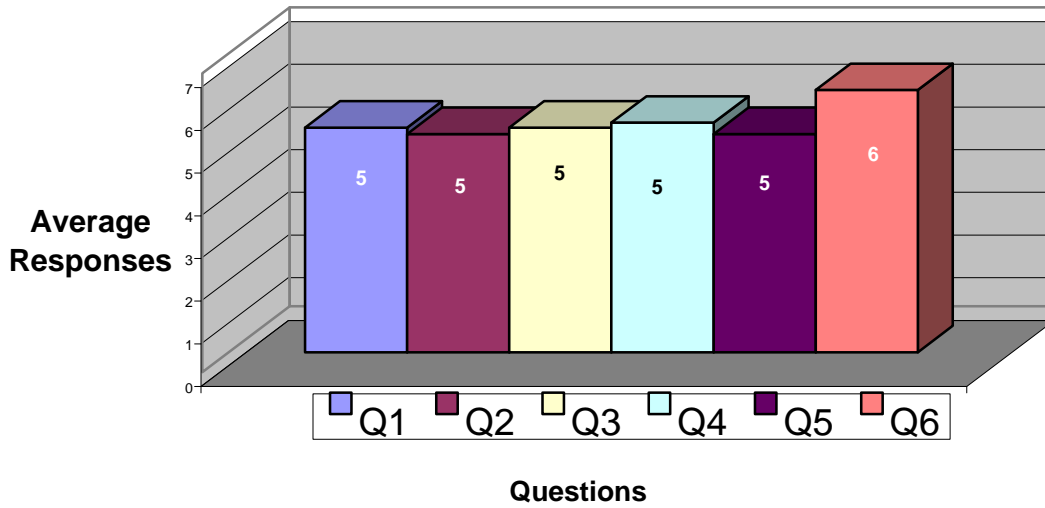


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Explanation for rating of Q6.

To think it is to make it possible
The same people gave their opinions - perhaps more people need to be directly asked to speak
It feels as though most people wanted the same thing and at least agreed with the new ideas brought to the table
It will have an influence but can only have influence to a certain degree due to all the ideas that are contributed!
Because I have had input and I will be "nagging" if I am not kept informed in the process all the way
Most consultation required before I will feel most confident Council feedback to continue
I can't expect that my views will be taken as bible when there are a room full of other opinions that you will have to weigh up
All good things take time to build; hopefully all good ideas will be kept, shared and used as a basis to form the structure of the vision!
I believe my ideas are valuable, but I am not confident about the extent they will be accepted
I need face to face communication to ensure that I have been understood I also tend to develop ideas better through discussion with others which this workshop encouraged
Because there are a large amount of people I don't feel that all the surveys will be read thoroughly and recorded
I thought the workshop was good. We need more movement eg trads. Move to different people but move to fresh air etc, Good to see the Gubbi Gubbi here hope they put some ideas in the process.
I've been disappointed by the lack of (council) response to community in past (15yrs). I maintain hope and will work to stimulate positive hopeful community participation.
Past experience shows that these workshops offer result in a document but no action NB The value of an idea is its implantation.
I am not confident that exercise will go into sufficient detail that the action plan will be correctly targeted.
History
Have been involved in similar workshops and affect of input is rarely well communicated back to participants
Issue of timing was taken on board. Needs to be longer.
Wasn't convinced that the strong concerns re geographic area were going to be reconsidered.
Because I gave general answers rather than specific
While there was some dissent about creating three regions individually, I feel the point about involving the community was taken
Our feedback, while quite critical, seemed to be well received and I'm looking forward to the continuation of this process
The voice of one compared to the voice of many. I can achieve little on my own but as part of a group I can achieve anything
Can I persuade others to express their ideas, I learned much from others, and will I be able to encourage others?
Had some bad experiences in the past with tokenistic public consultation processes. I remain hopeful for this important process.

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Additional Comments
I look forward to discuss further ideas and in more detail
Steven Ames was great, but the rest of it was not as inspiring as it could have been
Be careful as the leaders in this workshop that you don't use it as your own soapboxes - don't be led into arguments with overly focussed individuals
It will be a great process if managed properly!
Data collection could have been more comprehensive and accessible because this is time consuming. It can help community to make informed decisions
